## Men

- Open: 2:55:00 and 1:23:00
- 40+: 3:10:00 and 1:30:00
- 50+: 3:30:00 and 1:40:00
- 60+: 3:45:00 and 1:48:00

## Women:

- Open: 3:23:00 and 1:37:00
- 40+: 3:38:00 and 1:44:00
- 50+: 3:52:00 and 1:50:00
- 60+: 4:13:00 and 2:00:30
